Brief Description of Work:

Informatics Tutoring Scheme is a project in which Informatics students and staff support Scottish Computer Science and Maths exam-level high school students through small group tutorial sessions. All in-person sessions will be group sessions, no one-to-one sessions will take place in person. No sessions will take place until all tutors receive their PVGs. All tutors are registered STEM Ambassadors.

If the sessions are co-organised by another group/charity, then a representative of that group will be at hand during sessions to help if any issues occur.
